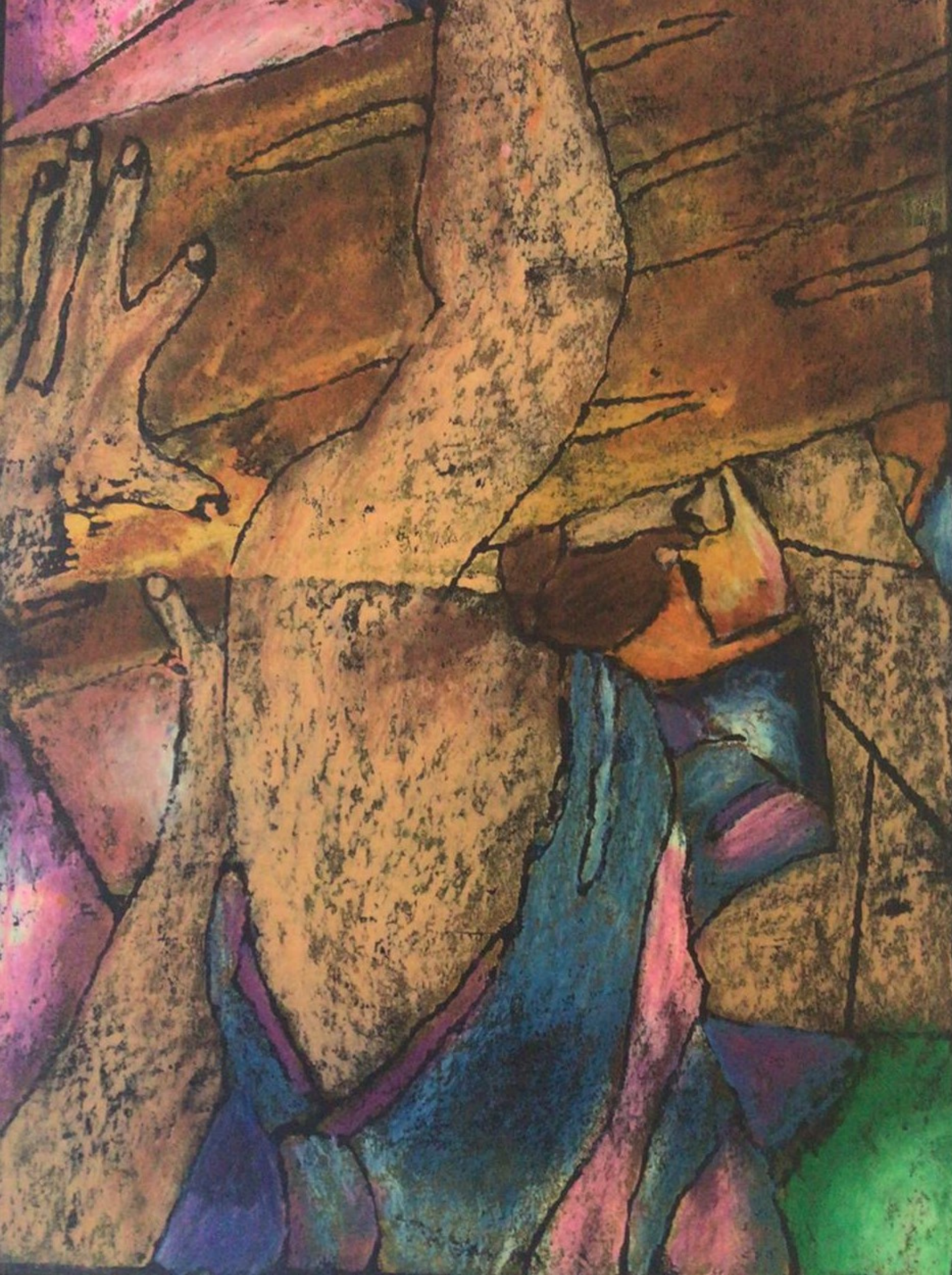

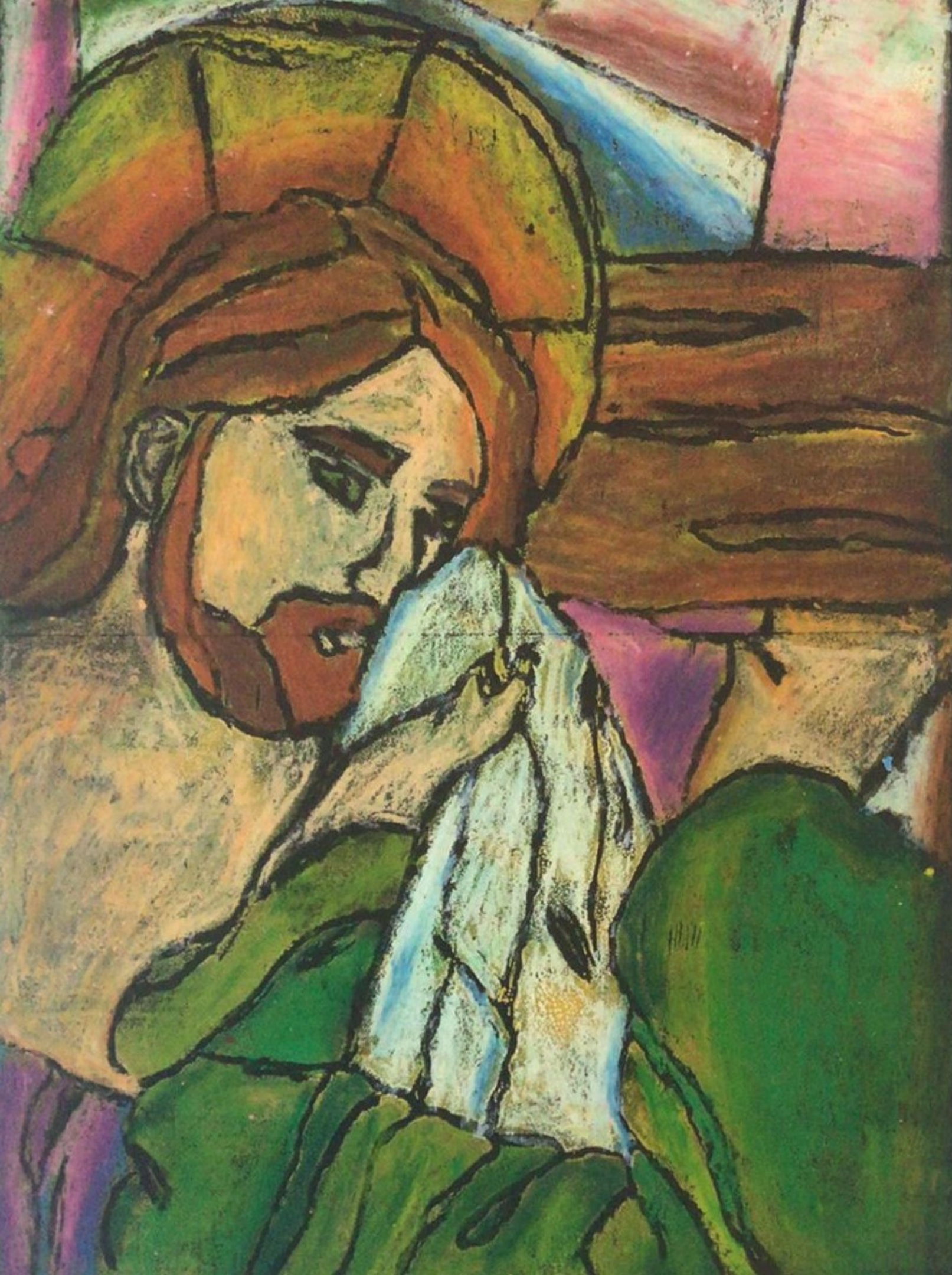


Simon of Cyrene helps Jesus to Carry his Cross

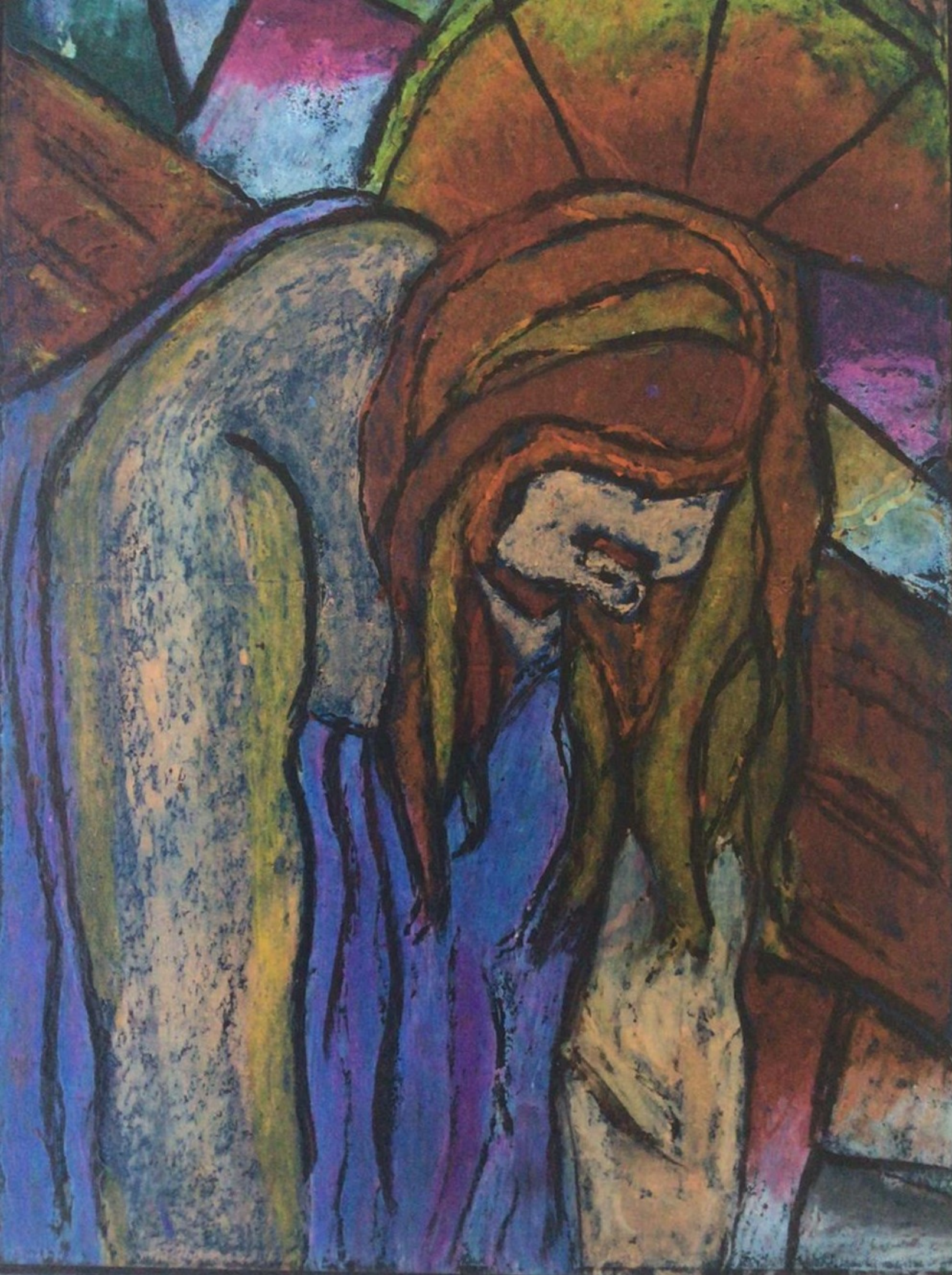

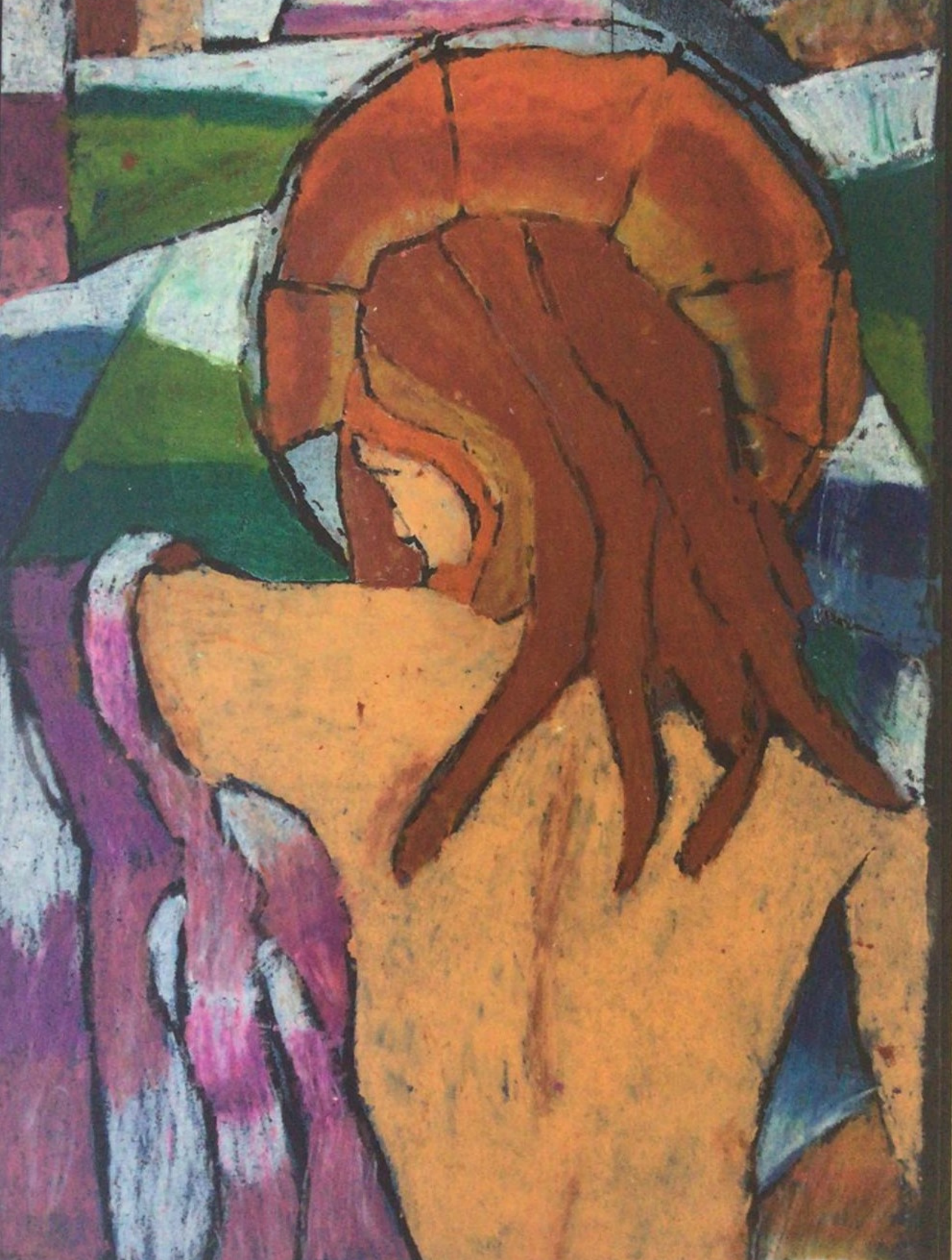

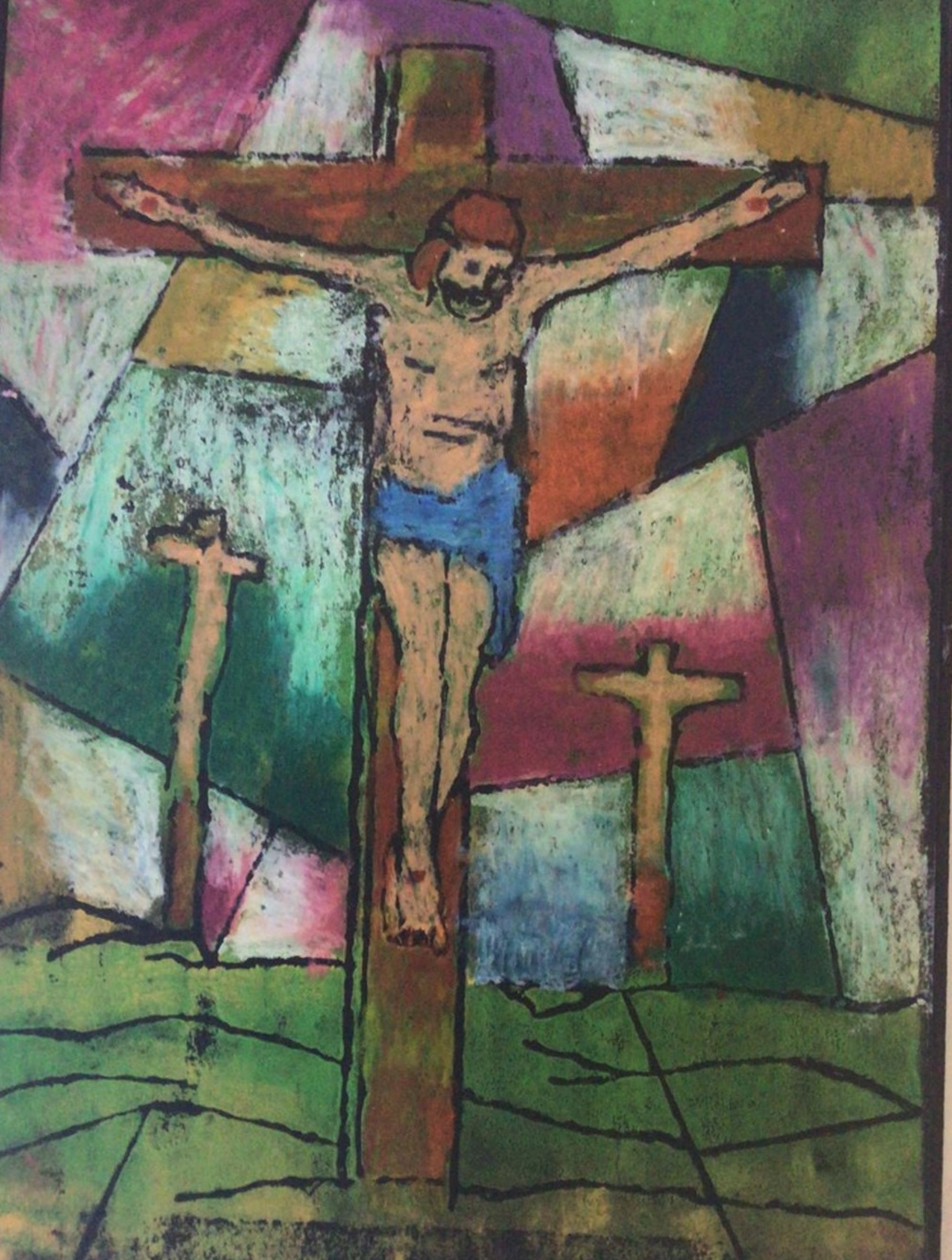


Jesus is Stripped of his Garments

Pray: Help me now to wait, in prayer, with you Jesus at the tomb, to comfort you and to love you. Amen

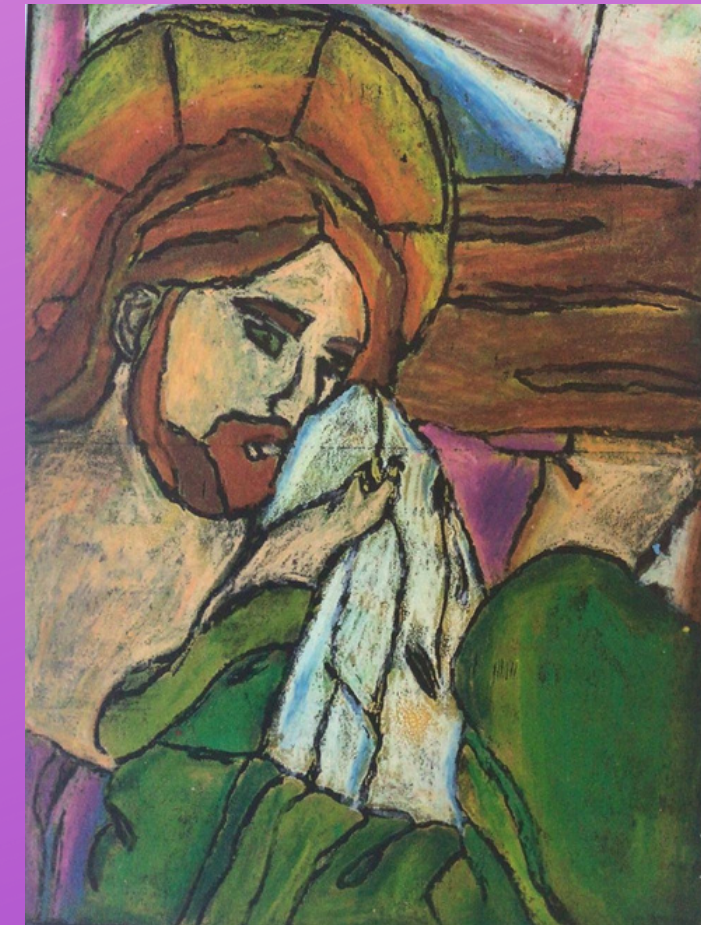
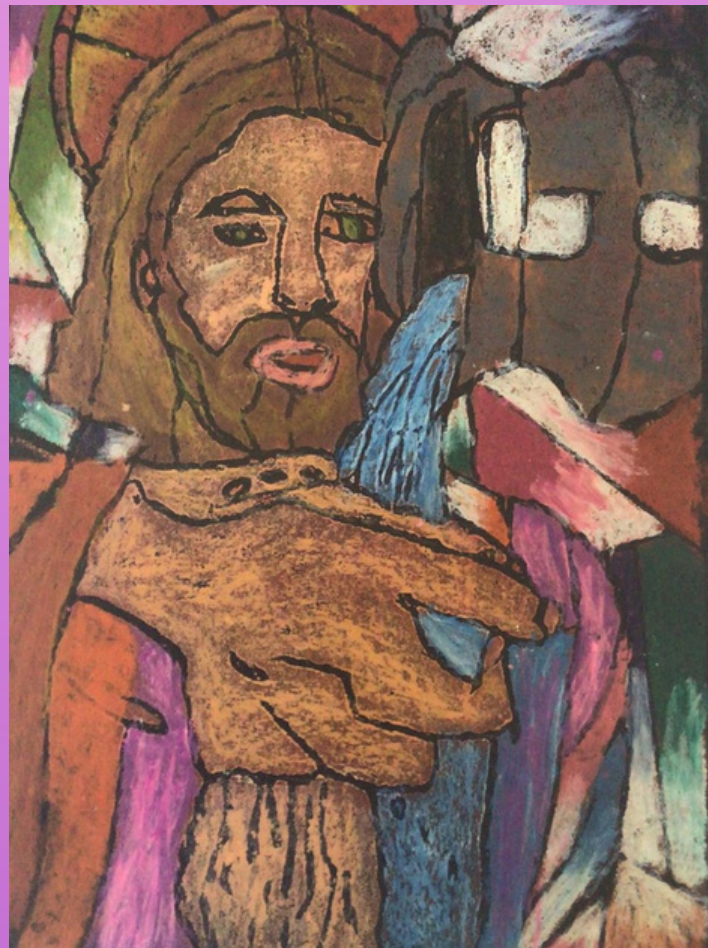
The Resurrection
